## **Betty Woodman**

Betty Woodman, renowned ceramic artist, died at 87. Ms. Woodman is best known for her abstract amphoras. Although flat and often displayed on the wall, the sculptures remain evocative of the classic ceramic vessels. Her retrospective in 2006 at the Metropolitan Museum of Art was a breakthrough for being by a living artist and one who worked in clay.
